TPSF has worked to identify unmet needs in our schools and will continue to develop programs for next year. Here are **some** of our initiatives for 2009-10:

**Save our Sports:**

TPSF is committed to helping ensure that **after-school sports** are available to middle school students. Although the state budget crisis caused sports to be eliminated from the TUSD budget, a team of committed coaches, principals, parents and administrators have come up with a plan to keep basketball, cross country, soccer, track and volleyball in all five middle schools next year. Parents will be asked to pay the cost of each sport if they can, and the Tustin Public Schools Foundation will work with the community to raise funds to ensure that EVERY student that wants to participate can play.



**Elementary Music**

A unique collaboration has formed to address a casualty of the state budget crisis - **elementary school band and orchestra**. To help partially fill the gap, TPSF is working with the City of Tustin and the Tustin Unified School District to provide after-school band and orchestra for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students for a small fee. Help is needed to raise funds to make sure that EVERY interested student has a chance to play an instrument.
